



Monarch Learning Center Science Faire 2011-2012

Dear Parents & Students,

This year, Monarch Learning Center will hold its annual Science Faire a little bit earlier than we have in the past. The dates of the Faire are Thursday and Friday, December 8th and 9th. The Booster and Social Committee will host our annual Winter Dinner on Thursday evening, December 8th, so that after dinner, families may view the Science Faire displays and projects in Rooms 3, 4 and 5.

This year's theme is Life Science, also known as Biology. Students will be given time to complete their projects at school, but may benefit from some extra research time at home. We want to stress that these are the children's projects, and they learn more from gentle guidance and coaching than from having things done for them. Here is the timeline for this year's Science Faire:

Friday, October 21, 2011	Students commit to their groups and choose their topic
Friday, October 28, 2011	Room 1 & 2 students are assigned to Room 3, 4 or 5 groups to do art support
Wednesday, December 7, 2011	Completed Projects are Due at Monarch
Thursday & Friday, December 8 th & 9 th , 2011	MLC Science Faire
Thursday, December 8, 2011	Winter Dinner, 6:00 PM

Students will work on their projects in groups; students in Rooms 3, 4 & 5 may be assigned a written report detailing what was learned. The format and requirements for the report may vary from class to class. Please watch for notes to come home from your child's teacher with the details of any class assignments related to the Science Faire.
